INTERNATIONAL COMPETITION OF U.T.V.A. 2024

Article 1: Every shooter must possess a valid shooting license.

Article 2: Shooting will take place only during the scheduled times.

Article 3:

1 "Youth" category (M + C + J)

2 "Adult" categories: Lady and Senior (D – S)

1 "Para-Shooting" category

- a) 10m Rifle and 10m Pistol: 4 categories (Youth Lady Senior Para-Shooting)
- b) 50m Rifle: **50 meter rifle prone**: 4 categories (Youth Lady Senior Para-Shooting) **50 meter rifle three positions**: 3 categories (Youth Lady Senior) T.A.R (cf. article 17) and Mini ISR (cf article 6): single category
- c) 25m Pistol: 3 categories (Youth Lady Senior)
- d) Kuchenreuter Mariette: single category (original and replica)
- e) Military Speed (cf. article 18 T.A.R): single category
- f) Pistol-Revolver (cf. article 19 T.A.R) (precision and gongs): single category 1 series in 18 seconds and one series in 8 seconds for the gongs

For "e)" and "f)" Only the following calibers are allowed:

.32 caliber (7.65mm)

9mm caliber (.38 and .357)

9mm LUGER

.45 COLT caliber (11.43mm): lead bullet

Article 4: Matches will be conducted and points will be counted according to French Shooting Federation regulations.

Article 5: 50m Regulation Shooting (only with .22 LR rifle - Rifle loan available on-site).

Article 6: Mini ISR rules for international competition:

- 50m distance in prone position
- Military training weapons similar to TAR 50m (820-823) .22 LR manual repeating with 5-round magazine or single shot
- 1 test target: unlimited number of cartridges in 5 minutes
- No telescope, permanent target carrier



- 3 series of 10 shots in 20 minutes (3 targets); the shooter switches their own targets
- Points checked on-site; in case of a tie, the number of center hits will decide
- Same commands as in TAR 50m

Article 7: Additional matches can be shot to improve one's score, depending on availability (registration possible on-site). Only the highest score will be considered and rewarded.

Article 8: A team ranking will be made if at least three teams are registered.

Article 9: Teams must be registered before the first shooter from the club starts their match; otherwise, that shooter will not be part of the team.

Article 10: At the awards ceremony:

- **Individual:** The top 6 in each category will be called to the podium. A bottle of champagne will be drawn among these 6 present shooters (or their representatives).
- **Team:** If at least three teams are registered and present, all will be called to the podium, and a bottle of champagne will be drawn.

Consequently, if the minimum number of participants is not reached, the bottle of champagne will not be offered.

Article 11: A bottle of Champagne will be awarded for:

- P25: at least one series of 96 points
- Kuchenreuter: a match of at least 98 points
- Mariette: a match of at least 95 points
- TAR 50m: at least one series of 100 points
- Mini ISR: at least two series of 100 points
- Rifle pron. and 10m Rifle: at least two series of 104 points
- Rifle 3 positions: a match of at least 565 points
- 10m Pistol: at least one series of 98 points
- Military Speed: a match of at least 193 points
- Pistol-Revolver: 5 gongs in 8 seconds and 5 gongs in 18 seconds

Article 12: Prizes not claimed during the awards ceremony will remain with U.T.V.A.

Article 13: U.T.V.A. declines all responsibility in case of theft, loss, or accident.

Article 14: All competitors are invited to the Sunday afternoon cocktail during the awards ceremony free of charge.

Article 15: If none of a club's shooters can attend the awards ceremony, the designated representative(s) may collect their prizes but will not be able to represent a team.

Article 16: Participation in this competition implies acceptance of these rules.

Article 17:

The event proceeds as follows:

- 5 trial shots in the prone position at 50m (5 minutes);
- 10 precision shots in the prone position at 50m (7 minutes);
- 10 rapid-fire shots in the standing position at 50m (5 minutes).

Article 18:

The event proceeds as follows on a Rapid fire pistol target:

- 1 series of 5 trial shots in 20 seconds, with 1 or 2 hands at 25m;
- 2 series of 5 match shots in 20 seconds, with 1 or 2 hands at 25m;
- 2 series of 5 match shots in 10 seconds, with 1 or 2 hands at 25m.

Article 19:

The event proceeds as follows:

- 5 trial shots, with 1 or 2 hands on a C50 target at 25m (3 minutes);
- 10 precision shots (2 reloads of 5 cartridges) with 1 hand, freestanding on a C50 target at 25m (7 minutes);
- 20 rapid-fire shots on metal gongs (20 cm x 20 cm) with 1 or 2 hands in 2 series of 2×5 cartridges each, the first in 18 seconds and the second in 8 seconds, all at a distance of 25m.
